# Creative Bromley

The theme for this year's painting, photographic and poetry competition is Darwin and his time in Bromley.



Charles Darwin lived and worked at Down House, Downe from 1842 until his death in 1882.

The different habitats of Downe and the surrounding area provided Darwin with a wide range of plants and animals which he could study as he looked for evidence to support his theory of evolution, which was written in *The Origin of Species*.

Through looking at plants and animals and the way they have evolved, Darwin realised that the mechanism driving evolution is natural selection - that plants and animals adapt to their environment and they are able to breed and pass on whatever makes them successful to their offspring.

Draw, paint, photograph or write a poem about Darwin in Bromley. Take your inspiration from the landscape of Downe, Cudham Valleys and Keston or how Darwin influenced the way we look at local flora, fauna, bugs and beasts.

## How to enter

Please ensure all work is clearly labelled on the reverse with the your name, contact details, photographic, arts or literary society or club (if applicable), age (under 18s only), category entered and price if you wish to sell the work. 20% commission payable on works sold.

Maximum size of painting, framed or unframed canvases: 600 by 420mm.

Maximum size of photograph, framed or mounted: 350 by 250mm.

Photographs and paintings must be supplied with a suitable horizontal wire or string for hanging.

Poems should be hand written and no more than one side of A4 in length.

You must supply written permission or a model release form with photographs of identifiable people.

Must be entrant's own work.

One entry per person, per category.

Entrance fee: £3 per item (under 18s free).

Entries will be judged in the following age groups: under 5s, 5-11s, 11-18s and over 18s.

Exhibition entries from individuals under 18 must be delivered to the Ripley Arts Centre between 11:00 and 13:00 on 29 June and collected between 09:00 and 11:00 on 13 July.

Exhibition entries from individuals over 18 must be delivered to the Ripley Arts Centre between 11:00 and 13:00 on 13 July and collected between 09:00 and 11:00 on 27 July.

School entries must be submitted in digital form as jpgs via e-mail to [celebrate.bromley@bromley.gov.uk](mailto:celebrate.bromley@bromley.gov.uk). If the work is selected for the exhibition, the original artwork must be available.

A maximum of 10 entries per category, per school.

The under 18s exhibition will be on display at the Ripley Arts Centre from 30 June to 10 July. Public viewing on 30 June and 6 July from 09:00-12:00. A private view will be held on 3 July 19:00-21:00.

The over 18s exhibition will be on display from 14 July to 24 July. Public viewing on 14 and 20 July from 09:00-12:00. A private view will be held on 17 July 19:00-21:00.
