Oxleas Adult Autism Assessment Pathway

This flow chart sets out the Autism assessment pathway for adults 18 years and older who do not have a learning disability and are concerned they may have an Autistic Spectrum Disorder (ASD).

Referral to the Oxleas Adult Autism Assessment Service

There are two ways you can be referred to the Adult Autism Assessment Service:

- 1) By a service provided by Oxleas NHS trust e.g. Adapt Team (Anxiety, Depression, Affective disorders, Personality disorders and Trauma), ICMP Team
- (Intensive Case Management for Psychosis (Schizophrenia and Bi-polar)
- 2) By your GP or another service such as MIND or Talk Together Bromley



The Assessment Team:

Psychologist Occupational Therapist Speech and Language Therapist You will be allocated a clinician who will undertake your assessment. You may also meet with other members of the team as part of your assessment

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You will be discharged from the Adult Autism Assessment Service
