



# **BICYCLE CHECK**

Cyclists attending a course must come with a suitable roadworthy bike, well fitting helmet and should be familiar and comfortable with their equipment. Usually a bike that a cyclist is used to is far better than a brand new bike that they are not confident on. The cycling team or bike shop will be able to advise you.

The following shops have agreed to conduct a Bikeability compatible safety check for a 'one off' £10 fee for those taking part in a cycling course with the Road Safety Unit.

The bike shops recommend that bike, rider and helmet are brought in together for checking.

Comfortable reach on two working brakes is vital.

This bike check will ensure that the bike fits, is in roadworthy condition with brakes that the cyclist can operate. (Please note that should a more complex service or major works be required then the bike shop will need to make addition charges and will provide a quote that must be agreed before the works are carried out.)
