

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 Section 31(6)

I, GEORGE SHEPHARD CORMACK, Defence Land Agent London, for and on behalf of the SECRETARY OF STATE FOR DEFENCE, and acting under the authority conferred upon me by the said Secretary of State DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:-

1. The Secretary of State for Defence on the 28th day of March 1974 in accordance with Section 34(6) of the Highways Act 1959 caused to be deposited with the London Borough of Bromley Council maps numbered 59A/74 and 93/74 of certain Establishments vested in the Secretary of State within the area administered by such Council together with statements indicating what ways over that land were admitted by the Secretary of State to have been dedicated as highways.


2. In accordance with Section 31(6) of the Highways Act 1980 no additional way over the land delineated on the map numbered 93/74 so deposited with the London Borough of Bromley Council or that part of the land delineated on the map numbered 59A/74 so deposited with the London Borough of Bromley Council which is still vested in the Secretary of State as shown by red edging on the attached map numbered 59B/74 has been dedicated as a highway since 20th February 1978 being the date of previous Declarations in accordance with the said section of the 1959 Act.

LEGEND

- a. Ministry of Defence boundaries are shown by *green* ~~red~~ edging.
- b. Over each route shown by a continuous *blue* ~~black~~ line, the Secretary of State recognizes a highway over which the public have a right of way on foot only.
- c. Over each route shown by a continuous green line, the Secretary of State recognizes that the public have the following, but no other, rights of way, that is to say, a right of way on foot and a right of way on horseback or leading a horse, with or without a right to drive animals of any description along the highway.
- d. Over each route shown by a broken green line, the Secretary of State recognizes the way to be a highway other than a footpath or bridleway used by the public mainly for the purposes for which footpaths and bridleways are so used, or as a byway open to all traffic.
- e. Over each route shown by a continuous brown tint the Secretary of State recognizes the route as a public road over which the public has the right to pass for all purposes with or without animals or vehicles.
