










Larger population aged **50+ (35%)** compared to London **(27%)**


Smaller population aged **15-24 (10%)** compared to London **(12%)**

Resident population to rise by 6% to 351,841




20,750 0-4 year olds, 3.5% less than now

By 2027...

The ethnic minority populations are set to grow considerably:

- Black African by 45%
- Asian by 23%
- **Black Caribbean by 27%**
- Other Asian by 10%
 - Other Black by 32%



- Bromley has a large Gypsy Traveller community, concentrated in the Crays
- Research suggests Gypsies and Travellers are the most excluded ethnic minority in England
