

# Collection Calendar

This is your recycling and waste collection calendar starting from August 2025. This is for residents living in houses only as there are different arrangements for residents in flats.

1

All waste and recycling **must** be correctly presented for collection by **7am on collection day**.

2

All waste must be contained securely and placed within arm's reach of the pavement, **but not on it**.

3

Small electrical items, batteries and textiles must be placed in a separate loosely-tied bag.

4

Leave your recycling and waste out for collection until **5pm** before you report a missed collection.
