

Adoption Statement for the Bromley Local Plan 16th January 2019

In accordance with Regulation 26 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended) (“the 2012 Regulations”), this Adoption Statement hereby gives notice that on 16 January 2019 the London Borough of Bromley adopted the Bromley Local Plan as a development plan document.

The Bromley Local Plan was the subject of an independent examination conducted by Elizabeth Hill BSc (Hons) BPhil MRTPI, an Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State in August 2017. In her report published in December 2018, the Inspector confirmed that the Plan was sound, subject to a number of main modifications. The main modifications recommended by the Inspector, together with additional minor modifications are included in the adopted Bromley Local Plan. These can be viewed on the Council’s website www.bromley.gov.uk/LocalPlan

Any person aggrieved by the Bromley Local Plan may, with the leave of the High Court, make an application under Section 113(3) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 to quash the Plan on the grounds that:

- a. the Bromley Local Plan is not within the powers conferred by Part 2 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004; or
- b. a procedural requirement has not been complied with.

Any such application for leave must be made to the Court no later than the end of the period of six weeks beginning with the day after the date on which the Bromley Local Plan was adopted (i.e. beginning on 16 January 2019).
