Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer in the borough where the elector is registered by **5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2024.** Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate.
