The Early Years Inclusion Team provides an early intervention and advice service for children with a wide range of special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND) and their families. Early Years Inclusion Practitioners (EYIPs) form part of this team.

Who are we?

EYIPs are a skilled team of Early Years professionals, supporting practitioners and parents who provide care for children with additional needs.



How do we get involved?

Usually via an allocation from the Area SENCo, but also via the setting requesting support.

What do we do?

We can offer practical support to practitioners around strategies, training, modelling and guidance in a variety of ways. This may include:

Supporting a setting:

- Advice/support around referrals or associated paperwork
- Practical modelling of approaches
- Training
- Observation and feedback to practitioners
- Signposting to services
- Advice/support around resources
- At meetings

Supporting a family:

- An agreed number of home visits personalised to the presenting needs in the home at that time
- As a supportive point of contact
