

Terms and conditions for Recruitment Advertising

By using the website, and in consideration of Bromley Council allowing you access to it, you accept and agree to be bound by these terms and conditions ("Terms"). From time to time we may modify the Terms, so please continue to review them whenever accessing or using the website.

You may only access and use the Bromley Council Recruitment website and services if you agree to all these terms and conditions and by continuing to use the website you are agreeing to these terms and conditions as varied from time to time.

General Terms & Conditions

You must be a public sector, voluntary or third sector organisation.

All prices quoted exclude VAT which will be charged at the current rate, where applicable.

Bromley Council does not accept any responsibility or liability for the content of adverts published on behalf of any third party organisation.

Prior to submitting any Recruitment Advertisements you will have obtained all necessary rights, consents, licences, clearances and waivers in relation to the Recruitment Advertisements (and all content thereof) to enable Bromley Council to publish the Recruitment Advertisements on the website and, as between Bromley Council and you, you shall be solely responsible for any and all payments due to third parties as a result of such publication.

All copyright, trademarks, and other intellectual property rights used as part of the website are vested in Bromley Council and its licensors.

You acquire no rights or licences in or to the website other than the limited right to use the website solely in accordance with these terms and conditions.

These Terms are governed by English law and the English Courts shall have non-exclusive jurisdiction.

General Terms Regarding Use of the Services:

You hereby warrant, represent and undertake to Bromley Council that:

You will only use the Services and any information you receive under the Services for your recruitment related activities;

Your use of the Services will not be prejudicial to the image or reputation of Bromley Council, the Website or any other recruiters who use the Website;

You are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of your account, profile and passwords, as applicable. Recruitment Advertisements

A Recruitment Advertisement may not contain:

- (d) the names of colleges, cities, states, towns or countries that are unrelated to the posting;
- (e) inaccurate, false, or misleading information;

You may not use your Recruitment Advertisements to:

- (a) post jobs in a manner that does not comply with applicable local, national and international laws, including but not limited to laws relating to labour and employment, equal employment opportunity and employment eligibility requirements, data privacy, data access and use, and intellectual property;
- (b) post jobs or other advertisements for competitors of Bromley Council or post jobs or other content that contains links to any site competitive with Bromley Council;

- (d) endorse a particular political party, political agenda, political position or issue;

General Terms Regarding Access to the Services:
